

**WHEATON WARRENVILLE SOUTH HIGH SCHOOL
SUMMER SCHOOL DRIVER EDUCATION - 2010**

Session I: June 10 – July 22 7:00 – 12:00

Session II: June 10 – July 22 10:00 – 3:00

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a two phase correlated program which fulfills the state requirements for obtaining a driver's license before a student's eighteenth birthday. The classroom phase emphasizes the theory of good driving practice, safety precautions, and stresses the development of good attitudes toward driving safely. The car phase permits the practice and perfection, as much as possible, in the art of driving a vehicle.

GENERAL INFORMATION

It is extremely difficult to take Driver Education and any additional Summer School courses/sports clinics or to be scheduled for day time employment during this period of time. This two-phase program requires daily class attendance and "on street" driving instruction. The two phases of the program may not necessarily be scheduled consecutively, on any given day. Students must be available from Session I: 7:00 – 12:00 & Session II: 10:00 – 3:00 daily during the 7 week session. Students will receive a class schedule on the first day of class . Students are allowed no more than two absences during the seven week session.

Prerequisite: Student must be sixteen (16) before June 9, 2011

STATE DRIVER ED REQUIREMENT: District 200 requires that a student must have earned a minimum of six credits in the two previous semesters in order to enroll in Summer Driver Ed. It is the student's responsibility to provide an official copy of the two previous semesters' grades if these are not available at WWSHS.

REGISTRATION - Enrollment is limited to 48 students based on birth date and school credits (minimum of 6). If any openings after February 5th, enrollment will be first come, first served.

Cost: \$250.00 summer course registration. Payment is due at the time of registration.

A student not attending a District 200 school but who lives in District 200 must furnish at the time of registration an official transcript showing at least two previous semesters of grades from his/her current school. Also two documents verifying residency (lease, tax bill or mortgage book plus current utility bill and drivers lic. at that address) are required at that time.
