

**WHEATON WARRENVILLE SOUTH HIGH SCHOOL
SUMMER SCHOOL DRIVER EDUCATION - 2008**

Session I: June 9 – July 18 7:00 – 12:00

Session II: June 9 – July 18 10:00 – 3:00

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a three phase correlated program which fulfills the state requirements for obtaining a driver's license before a student's eighteenth birthday. The classroom phase emphasizes the theory of good driving practice, safety precautions, and stresses the development of good attitudes toward driving safely. The simulator phase introduces the student to proper driving conditions. The car phase permits the practice and perfection, as much as possible, in the art of driving a vehicle.

GENERAL INFORMATION

It is extremely difficult to take Driver Education and any additional Summer School courses/sports clinics or to be scheduled for day time employment during this period of time. This three-phase program requires daily class attendance, additional time for simulation and "on street" driving instruction. The three phases of the program may not necessarily be scheduled consecutively, on any given day. Students must be available from Session I: 8:00 – 12:00 & Session II: 10:00 – 2:00 daily during the 7 week session. Students will receive a class schedule on the first day of class. Students are allowed no more than two absences during the seven week session.

Prerequisite: Student must be sixteen (16) before June 1, 2009

STATE DRIVER ED REQUIREMENT: A student must have passed a minimum of eight (8) courses in the two previous semesters in order to enroll in Summer Driver Ed. It is the student's responsibility to provide an official copy of the two previous semesters' grades if these are not available at WWSHS.

REGISTRATION - Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis, and limited to 48 students

A student not attending a District 200 school but who lives in District 200 must furnish at the time of registration an official transcript showing at least two previous semesters of grades from his/her current school. Also two documents verifying residency (lease, tax bill or mortgage book plus current utility bill and drivers lic. at that address) are required at that time.
